#### TRANSFER OPTIONS

- Completed AA or AS degree: all courses will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis. Having completed an AA/AS degree does not necessarily meet the General Education core at Carthage.
- **Completing some courses at CLC**: Students will have to follow Carthage's general education requirements to meet the general education component of the baccalaureate degree.
- **Guaranteed Transfer Admission Partner**: Students may apply for the GTA a year before they plan to matriculate. To learn more please visit www.clcillinois.edu/GTA

#### TRANSFER CREDITS

The maximum number of semester hours transferable from a community college to meet Carthage graduation requirements is 68. Minimum grade of C- Required for course transfer. Course equivalences: <a href="https://www.transferology.com/school/carthage">www.transferology.com/school/carthage</a>

# <u>ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS</u>

Transfer Student = 12 or more college level credit hours; students with less than 12 college level credit hours must submit official high school transcripts including ACT or SAT scores.

# **CALCULATION OF ADMISSION GPA**

Developmental courses and other non-transferable courses will not be used in calculation of GPA for admission. Only courses with a grade of C- or lower may be repeated. When a course is repeated, the earlier grade remains on the student's transcript, but the new grade is factored into the cumulative GPA and the old grade is removed from the calculation. On multiple attempts the most recent grade will be used in computing the cumulative grade point average.

#### **APPLICATION**

Admissions is rolling but an early application is encouraged. Financial aid awarding for fall transfers typically begins in March for the following fall term, and September for the spring term. We strongly recommend filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). (Carthage FAFSA school code=003839). Most students qualify for some Carthage financial aid.

#### FOREIGN LANGUAGE REQUIREMENT

There is no foreign language requirement for admission, however, students are required to either complete or test out of two semesters of college foreign language, consecutively and in the same language in order to graduate.

#### **SCHOLARSHIPS**

Competitive scholarships are available for fall and spring entering students (visit <a href="https://www.carthage.edu/admissions/transfer/scholarships/">https://www.carthage.edu/admissions/transfer/scholarships/</a> for more information). At least one full tuition scholarship and one \$25,000 scholarship is awarded each competition (each renewable for three years). Full time transfer students with a 2.30+ transfer GPA are eligible for a tuition scholarship up to \$13,000, regardless of need. Higher GPAs make a student eligible for a larger scholarship. PTK scholarship of \$1,500 for current members. A variety of grants available.
